In September 2015 the international community agreed to the headquarters of the United Nations Agenda 2030 and its respective 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), a roadmap to face the challenges of the world. For the first time in an international development agenda, reference is made to higher education. The SDG on education "SDG 4: ensuring inclusive, equitable and quality education and promoting lifelong learning opportunities for all" refers explicitly to it and therefore higher education institutions are called to develop a essential role in the dissemination and application of Agenda 2030. Engineering and Engineering education play a key core role in contributing to social transformation and sustainable development. The Sustainability SIG group aims at promoting and catalyzing this needed transformation within Engineering Education in the SEFI community and beyond.

The group has not been very active due to healthy issues of its chair.
